Air travel can be stressful for domestic pets and it is your responsibility to ensure that your pet is fit to undertake the journey. By presenting your pet for carriage you hereby acknowledge and accept the Terms and Conditions outlined below. Passengers with unsuitable pet carriers will be refused travel and tickets not refundable.

- I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Aurigny Air Services Limited, its Directors, officers, staff and agents against any and all liability arising from the transportation of my pet by air, except in the case of wilful misconduct of the carrier.
- I understand the carriage of pets is entirely at my own risk and that Aurigny Air Services Limited accepts no liability whatsoever arising from the consequences of undertaking this journey
- I confirm my pet has been provided with a purpose built (IATA approved) secure plastic/wood, leak-proof sturdy container of a size not exceeding L90cm x W60cm x H75cm and weight, including animal and a waterproof blanket, of no more than 23Kgs. Soft carriers are NOT suitable.
- I confirm that my dog (not applicable to cats) will wear a muzzle from the point of entering the terminal, throughout the journey, until I have left the terminal at the destination.
- I confirm my pet is at least 8 weeks old, in good health, free from disease and fit for the journey.
- In the event of a delay I will be responsible for the welfare of my pet
- I confirm that in the event the aircraft is diverted or delayed overnight, I am responsible for the welfare of my pet during the delay and also find overnight accommodation for my pet if required.
- I confirm that if my pet has new scars (e.g. Operations) they must be accompanied by a vet's letter explaining nature of treatment and authorisation for travel.

Terms & Conditions

You must make sure that all animals travelling as part of the carriage of pets' policy are put in proper, adequate and secure containers. If you fail to do this, we will not carry the animal.

You must present to us all health and vaccination certificates, entry permits, transit permits, exit permits and other documents needed for the animals. If you fail to do this, we may decide not to carry the animal.

The animal must be at least 8 weeks of age.

Unless carrying the animal is covered by liability rules of convention, we will not responsible for their loss, sickness, injury or death unless we have been negligent.

We are not liable to you for any loss you suffer because you do not have the health and vaccination certificates, entry permit, exit permits and other documents needed for your animal. You must repay to us any fines, costs, charges, losses or liabilities we have paid or suffered because you did not have these documents.

Right of refusal. We reserve the right, at our absolute discretion, to refuse to carry any animals. All carriage is in accordance with the conditions of carriage detailed in the current edition of the IATA Live Animals Regulations.
