

Aurigny – Unaccompanied Passengers Aged 14 and 15

This form must be filled out by the parent/guardian (“you”) of the young passenger(s) (aged 14 or 15) travelling alone. Each young passenger must have their own passport for photographic ID.

Failure by the young passenger to carry this form at all times & to present it when requested by Aurigny staff or any other relevant agent, may result in refusal of carriage.

By signing this form:

- You give permission for the young passenger(s) listed below to travel unaccompanied.
- You understand that weather or other events may result in an aircraft diversion and overnight stay at another unplanned destination. You acknowledge that some taxi and hotel providers require formal, written consent in order for young passengers (under 16) to use their services and/or stay unaccompanied in the hotel.
- You hereby confirm that you give your consent to the young passenger travelling by taxi unaccompanied and to stay in a hotel room unaccompanied.
- You must also acknowledge that some taxi or hotel providers refuse to accept children aged 14 and 15 unaccompanied. In this instance, you give your consent for Aurigny to make the necessary contact with child protection authorities and/or the local law enforcement to assist.
